#### **REGULATORY PROCESS FOR THE REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF RADIATION WORKERS**

Pursuant to the provisions of the Radiation Protection Act Cap 243 Laws of Kenya and regulations therein, all radiation works apply for registration and/or licence to administer ionizing radiation **MUST** submit the following to the Board.

1. A duly completed GK LRP 4 licence application form (readily available at the Board's offices.) *Ref Sec 11 (1) Cap 243*
2. Certified copies of the following documents:
  - a) Academic certificates *Ref Sec 12(2) e Cap 243*
  - b) National Identify Card/Relevant pages of the passport
  - c) Professional Certificates and other testimonials *Ref Sec 12(2)e Cap 243*
  - d) Registration of Membership with a professional association *Ref Sec 12(2)e Cap 243*
  - e) Latest dosimetry results *Ref LN 54 sec 8*
  - f) Full haemogram results (half yearly) *Ref Sec 12(2)b Cap 243*
  - g) Updated curriculum vitae (CV) *Ref Sec 12(2)e Cap 243*
  - h) Work permit for non-Kenyan. *Ref Sec 12(2)e Cap 243*
3. Two (2) recent passport size photographs duly endorsed by employer. *Ref Sec 12(2)e Cap 243*
4. Registration fee of Kshs.1,000/= (paid once) and/or annual fees of Kshs.1,000/= *Ref schedule III of regulations.*
